THE RIPPLE EFFECTS OF TREES

A single large tree can supply a day's worth of oxygen for up to four people.



Tree roots help filter water by trapping pollutants and slowing down the flow of rainwater.



In one year, 100 mature trees remove 50 tons of CO₂, and 430 pounds of pollutants from the air.



Forests absorb up to 30% of global CO₂ emissions and 10-20% of U.S. fossil fuel emissions.

THE RIPPLE EFFECTS OF LIQUID COLOR.






Dispersing pigment into liquid uses **90% less energy**



Gravimetric technology typically provides **10% savings** over



volumetric technology through precise metering.

16% energy savings can occur when coloring a product with liquid, versus pellet.

Return for Refill[™] provides **zero waste** by reusing sealed containers yielding on average 12 cents per pound of color.



75% less weight for transporting liquid, versus pellet provides savings in fuel.
